- Full particulars regarding breed, age, colour, pedigree, NLIS number and name of beast must be provided on the Beef Cattle entry form.
- Classes listed will be held for four breed categories
- All beef cattle to be haltered
- All bulls 12 months and over must have a nose ring
- Heifer not to have a calf, unless otherwise stated
- All stock must be registered with recognised breed society
- Association ribbons will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd if more than 5 entries in any class
- Champion Male and Female sashes may be awarded for breed categories. All ribbons will be awarded at the discretion of the judge.
- Age of cattle, as of 1st September 2017
- Calves under 8 months may accompany their mother whilst being judged.
- Please complete a separate entry form for each breed category
- All cattle to have NLIS devices fitted
- All cattle must be tested for Pesti Virus
