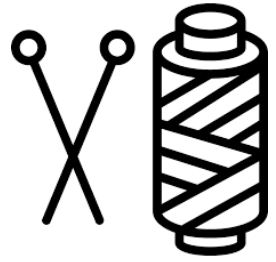
Conditions of Entry

STAGING ENTRIES	<p>Exhibits must be staged by MIDDAY on Wednesday 25th September 2019 at the Pavilion All exhibits must be clearly labelled with tags. Please bring a copy of ENTRY FORM to leave with Stewards to accompany your entries</p>
COLLECTING ENTRIES	<p>Exhibits to be COLLECTED from the Pavilion between 10am & 12noon on Sunday 29th Sept 2019 or must be collected between 10am & 2pm on Tuesday 1st Oct 2019 from the Secretary. Special arrangements must be made with the Pavilion Stewards for any alternative.</p>

Exhibitor Note	Use tacking thread half way around article to hold exhibit in place on cardboard, the use of pins of any kind is proving very unsuitable.
